


Randomizing Question Order and Answer Order in Brightspace Quizzes

In your quiz format assessments, there are multiple ways to randomize quiz content. At the quiz level you can randomize questions within a given quiz. But you can also randomize response options for individual questions.

Randomizing question order in a quiz:

1. Access the quiz you want to edit
2. Go to the the **properties tab**
3. **Check the shuffle questions box**
